

## Our Expectations

Guiding Question: **How do we communicate expectations to our students in ways that support understanding?**



Provide options for self-regulation  
 9.1 Promote expectations & beliefs that optimize motivation  
 9.2 Facilitate personal coping skills and strategies  
 9.3 Develop self-assessment and reflection

Definition of a Rubric:  
 A guide listing specific criteria for grading or scoring academic papers, projects, or tests.

Type of Rubric	What is it?	Pros	Cons	Link
<b>Holistic</b> 	One description of performance for each score level (CAASPP)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Takes less time: one overall score</li> <li>Combines skills for holistic product</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Does not always provide as targeted feedback</li> </ul>	<a href="http://bit.ly/holisticSHS">http://bit.ly/holisticSHS</a>
<b>Analytic</b> 	Multiple expectations separated in different rows & scored individually (SUSD writing rubrics).	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Helps break down each part of a task</li> <li>Justifies score and grade</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Takes time to create</li> <li>difficult to score &amp; calibrate (add up or average?)</li> </ul>	<a href="http://bit.ly/AnalyticSHS">http://bit.ly/AnalyticSHS</a>
<b>Single Point</b> 	Similar to analyze but gives criteria only for meeting standard; lists target criteria for with boxes to provide feedback.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Provides targeted feedback (concerns or opportunities)</li> <li>Less language; open ended</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Requires more writing when grading</li> <li>Not always as clear on the front end of item</li> </ul>	<a href="http://bit.ly/SinglePointSHS">http://bit.ly/SinglePointSHS</a>
